

## GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

(These rules pertain to all the shows in this book)

"Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith."

### USEF MEMBERSHIP RULE:

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$20 non-member registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk/trot and academy classes (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF Introductory Level tests, Pas de Deux and Quadrille classes; 7) NRHA endorsed Reining competitions, 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, or current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA Beginner Novice division; and 11) Assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

### USEF ENTRY AGREEMENT:

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulteur or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation (the Federation) and the local rules of the competition.

I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules.

I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered.

I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

**A copy of the appropriate, current USEF membership card(s) must be sent with entries. If a copy of the card(s) does not accompany the entry or is not presented upon checking in, then a member must sign an affidavit and pay a \$5.00 fee.**

**AMATEUR CERTIFICATION:** Every person who has reached his 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. USEF Chapter 13. Certification must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the Competition Secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such certification provided by the Federation.

**CHANGE OR CANCELLATION:** Management has the right to combine, cancel or split any classes it deems appropriate. Management reserves the right to reschedule any class for the overall good of the show, exhibitors to be notified as per USEF rules.

**CLASS ANNOUNCEMENTS:** Please be aware class calls are a courtesy to the exhibitor. Show management is not responsible for an exhibitor missing a class, although every effort will be made to maintain a working P.A. system.

**CONDUCT:** The Horse Protection Act of 1970, Public Law 91-540 as amended will be followed. Exhibitors are cautioned as to their conduct in the ring and in the schooling areas, especially with respect to training and schooling horses. Use of all rubber or elastic devices on legs are prohibited on the show grounds before or during this show. Violators will forfeit all trophies, ribbons and premiums previously won and will be barred from any further competition, and will have absolutely no recourse against the management of this show and its officials.

**DRUGS & MEDICATION:** In compliance with the USEF Drug and Medication Rule, a \$12.00 fee will be collected on all horses entered, including equitation horses. The Drugs and Medications fee has been incorporated into the USEF Fee and will continue to be assessed per horse, per competition. This includes the \$7.00 drug fee and a \$5.00 USEF fee. The Show Committee has requested USEF to test these shows for use of forbidden substances.

**ENTRIES:** Post entries are accepted. See specific show for fees. Please use entry blank appropriate to show. All entry blanks must be signed by Owner, Trainer and each Rider/Driver/Handler and Coach (if applicable). No one under 18 may sign.

**GOLF CARTS:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind; including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 7. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**NUMBERS:** A number will be assigned to each horse at the time the entry is received. That number will stand for the entire show and must be displayed whenever the horse is in the ring.

**PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR:** Riders in all classes where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds must wear protective headgear (Exception: Trail classes). All juniors riding in Hunter Seat Equitation sections, while riding anywhere on the competition grounds, must wear properly fitting protective headgear which passes or surpasses ASTM/SEI standards. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear in any division or class without penalty by the judge.

**PROTESTS:** As per USEF Chapter 6, Protests may be made to the Show Committee by an exhibitor, owner, agent, trainer or the parent of a junior exhibitor for any violation of USEF rules. It must be in writing, signed by the protester, addressed to the secretary of the competition at which the alleged violation occurred, accompanied by a deposit of \$200.00 (\$300 if made by a non-member) and received by the steward, technical delegate, a member of the Show Committee, the competition manager or the competition secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation.

**REGISTRATION:** Morgans shown must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Assn. Inc., or the Canadian Morgan Horse Association or the British Morgan Horse Society and must be entered under their full registered name and registration number, or if under one year of age, be eligible for registration. Horses must be entered under the names of the owner(s) or leasee of record with AMHA, CMHA or BMHS. A copy of the registration papers showing recorded ownership or proof of lease must be submitted with entry form at the time of making entry.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** All exhibitors in the horse show will be under the control and direction of the Show Management and said Management will not be responsible for loss, injury or damage to horses exhibited or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or in anyway damaged. You may report lost articles to the Show Secretary.

**SHARPS DISPOSAL:** It is the responsibility of each individual stable to properly dispose of needles, syringes and other bio-hazardous materials. Sharps containers will be placed in the barns. Please use them to dispose of these items.

# WHEAT STATE REGIONAL MORGAN HORSE SHOW

## AMHA MEMBERSHIP RULE

Life, Individual, and Junior AMHA Members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at the Wheat State Regional Morgan Horse Show. A non-member may participate as a rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, or trainer upon payment of a \$20 fee. Participants in the following classes are exempt from the requirements of this rule: 1. leadline, 2. exhibitions, 3. games and races, 4. classes for 4-H members, 5. walk-trot and academy classes. (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program.) and 6. USDF Introductory Level Tests, Pas de Deux and Quadrille Classes. Also exempt from this requirement are members in good standing of their national federation. ***A copy of the current AMHA card(s) must be sent with entries.***

**ENTRIES:** Entry and stall reservations must be accompanied with a check or money order, payable to the Wheat State Morgan Horse Assn. and mailed to Show Secretary, Carol Benedict, 4058 S 213<sup>th</sup> East Ave., Broken Arrow, OK 74014. All entries must be made on an official entry blank one owner per entry blank. Every exhibitor, rider, driver, handler, coach and trainer or his agent must sign an entry blank. In the case of a rider, driver or handler under the age of 18, his parent or guardian, or if not available, the trainer, must sign an entry blank on the minor's behalf.

**POST ENTRIES:** Entries not postmarked by the entry deadline, May 15, will be subject to a post entry fee of \$30.00 per horse. There is no post entry fee for additional classes for horses entered in the show prior to the deadline. Any added classes should be made by one hour before the start of the session. If added classes are not paid for at the time of entry, then a signed check made payable to the show must be deposited with the show secretary. Post entries in Dressage accepted only at discretion of Dressage Coordinator.

**CHAMPIONSHIPS:** All first, second and third place winners in qualifying classes are required to enter the championship, exhibitors must fill out & sign the official entry form in the office for these classes. All first and second place winners in In-Hand classes are required to enter the championships and will be automatically entered. Winners in Junior Horse classes, Junior Exhibitor classes, Amateur classes are not required to show back in Open Performance Championships: However, they will be required to show back in their respective Championships if offered.

**STABLING:** Stall assignments will be posted at the show office. Permanent stalls with full doors, some temporary stalls available. Flooring is concrete. Stalls will be available Monday, June 9, at noon at \$75 per stall. All horses must be removed from show grounds by noon June 16. Each animal must be assigned a separate stall, except broodmares with a suckling foal. Those showing out of trailers with no stall reservation must pay a grounds fee of \$15 per horse per day. The show will try to honor requests to be stalled with another exhibitor, but only if the request is made by both parties.

**BEDDING, FEED:** First bedding will not be provided. You may pre-order your bedding on your entry blank. If you plan to arrive before 8:00 a.m. or after 8:00 p.m., you MUST call the show secretary in advance to arrange for bedding, or bring your own

**CAMPERS, TRAILERS AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES:** The Kansas State Fair RV Park contains 211 full service hook-ups which include water, sewer and electricity. There are also 12 handicapped accessible sites. There are restroom facilities including showers and storm shelter facilities. Rates are \$20 per day, or \$126 per week. There are also hook-ups near the ExpoCenter (show arena) with electrical hook-ups *only*, at \$15 a day. Please make reservations by calling the Kansas State Fair at 620 669-3624 or 620 669-3608.

**REFUNDS:** If Management is notified prior to the entry deadline, all entry and stall fees will be refunded, less the office fee. After that date, entry fees only will be refunded if a veterinarian certificate is presented. Refunds will be mailed after the close of the show.

**ARENAS:** The indoor competition arena (ExpoCenter) is 98' by 263'. ExpoCenter II is an adjacent covered open-air warm-up arena, 95' x 187'. Footing in both arenas is a mixture of dirt and sand.

**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** All horses must have a negative Coggins test dated within 12 months of the last day of the show. The State of Kansas requires an official health certificate for out of state horses issued within the last 30 days.

**VETERINARIAN:** A veterinarian will be on call during each performance of the show. Name and phone number of veterinarian will be posted at the horse show office.

**NO SMOKING RULE:** Smoking is NOT permitted in any Kansas State Fair exhibit/livestock building.

**PETS:** Dogs and other pets may not be tied in the aisles of the barns and must be kept on leashes.

Correct gaits (which contribute to ease of training and equine soundness and usability) are more important than gaits which are merely superficially flashy. Horses to be shown on the line with one handler and one whip permitted (GR803). Class will be shown on the triangle according to DR 143.1. Horses to stand square or in the open position (DR 143.1-2). A horse shall be disqualified for unsoundness, as defined as showing evidence of lameness or broken wind. Horses under the age of two may be shown in halters. Horses two and older must be shown in a snaffle-type bit and bridle with a headstall and throatlatch. Bandages are forbidden. Braiding is optional. Entry fee \$20.00
